
Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets. Please note, this is the first year of reporting.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 82 tCO₂e by 2029 This is a reduction of 16.1%

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2023 baseline.
